



Process for IASR ethics applications

- All IASR staff and postgraduate research (PGR) student projects must receive ethical approval via the IASR Research Institute Ethics Panel
- Advance notification of ethics application (F1 form) is now required.

 This should ensure applications are dealt with promptly. Applications should be submitted **no later than three weeks** after notification

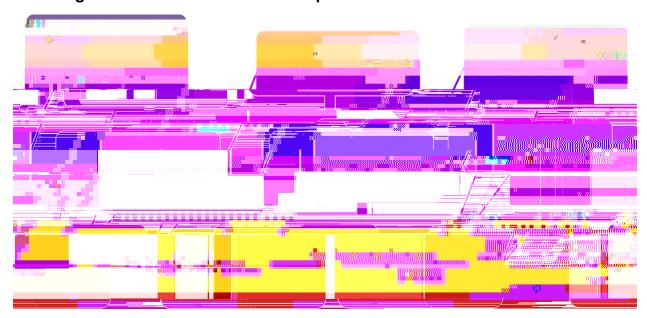


Figure 1 Overview of IASR ethics process and timelines

- Please see the Figure 1 for an overview of process and timelines. The full suite of forms can be downloaded from FORMS
