1. Purpose

The university is committed to the development of relationships and engagement in promotional activities with third party employers in order to source work-based and workplace learning and employment opportunities for students and graduates.

This policy will set out the ethical considerations which the University will consider when making careers and employability decisions. This relates to all activity including the sourcing of work-based and workplace learning and employment opportunities for students and graduates through activities such as careers fairs, curriculum involvement, volunteering, and student and graduate work-based learning.
