Overarching

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From 2020-21 we will conduct regular transition events for students with Autism/ASD and their parent/carers will be held on the University to support socialisation, familiarisation and awareness of support services available.

We will provide an increased level of early and continued intervention for young people in care from Year's 4-13, supporting the local authorities of Luton, Central Beds, Bedford and Milton Keynes. This will include, from 2020-21 providing an annual Looked After Children residential for young people in care from Years 5 & 6, focusing on multi-skills through multi-sports. Participants will be supported through a continued working model of intervention and support particularly at key transition points from primary to secondary.

We will identify, from 2020-21 a named contact for care leaver applicants within the Access and Outreach Team, who will support care leaver applicants through a contextually sensitive offer and admissions process.
